Solid Waste Disposal Rates

The Angel Fire Collection Center is a small municipal solid waste facility; it is NOT a landfill. We are limited as to the type and amount of material we can accept. We receive solid waste, and transfer it to the landfill.

Household Trash:

- Household trash may be brought to the Transfer Station or placed in one of the dumpsters located throughout the Village for this purpose.
- Dumpsters should be used in the following way:
 - Only household trash secured in garbage bags can be placed in the dumpster (not on top or to the side of the dumpster). Make sure the lid is closed and latched, otherwise you are littering!
- **Refrigeration units of all types: \$40 each**
- **Appliances other than refrigeration units: \$10 each**
- **Car and truck tires: \$2 to \$8** depending on size. Heavy equipment tires **\$10 to \$15** depending on size.
- **Construction Debris, furniture, mattresses, auto parts, large bulky items, vegetation mixed with stumps, logs 12" or greater in diameter, dirt or rocks: \$10 per cubic yard**
- **Clean Slash: \$3 per cubic yard** for residents who live *outside* the Village limits.

Hazardous materials are not accepted. Liquids of any type are not accepted. We do not accept septic tanks.

Recycling:

The Village of Angel Fire recycles corrugated cardboard, aluminum cans, scrap aluminum, #1 and #2 plastic bottles, printer cartridges, mercury switches, thermostats, thermometers, cell phones, rechargeable batteries, car batteries, motor oil and antifreeze.

The Village of Angel Fire reserves the right to refuse any load or material. Hazardous materials and liquids of any type cannot be accepted, as per New Mexico
